

eLearn Mentor-Led Training

The eLearn mentors propose and then lead training projects with full time and adjunct faculty in their areas, disciplines, and campuses. Trainings can be held in the afternoons leading up to 6:00 evening classes, on Saturdays, or during the summer—anytime outside the mentors’ regular office hours. Since they are faculty, eLearn mentors know the needs for training in their areas, disciplines, and campuses and the upcoming needs as they arise--eLearn tools, textbook ancillaries and test banks, vendor instructional systems, Respondus, SoftChalk, Camtasia or particular instructional and administrative tasks in their area such as department-wide pre/post tests, QEP “quiz” analysis and reporting, and assessment of mobilization. Adjunct faculty can be compensated for the training.
