## Instructional Design

Instructional Design plans, co-ordinates, and delivers training in teaching and learning technologies for faculty (and in some instances, staff) at Walters State. Instructional Design consists of technically-trained individuals and faculty members who work together across four campuses under the auspices of Distance Education. Instructional Design trains faculty in teaching/learning technologies including eLearn (the college's learning management system), mobilization, and a number of additional software packages and products—some that integrate into eLearn, some that integrate into mobilization and mobile devices, some that integrate with both, and some that are stand-alone products and packages. Instructional Design previews new software and hardware that might be of use in teaching and learning, pilots their use with select faculty, and if appropriate, trains faculty in their use. Instructional Design also assists faculty in designing, creating, developing, delivering, and reviewing online and hybrid courses. Instructional Design also assists faculty on a one-on-one basis in instructional design and delivery.
