Technology School for Faculty

IDT members can propose and then lead training projects for faculty during those days and times when faculty are not already on campus. Trainings can be held any time outside of faculty members' regular working days on campus. Topics can include—but are not limited to-- Dropbox, TurnItIn, evaluation of electronic papers and projects, and GRADES; Discussion forums, discussion boards, appropriate question types for discussion boards (via Bloom taxonomy), and GRADES; Open Educational Resources, hyperlinks, pages of CONTENT, and GRADES; Library databases, persistent links, pages of CONTENT, and GRADES; Quizzes 1: Quiz Management; Quizzes 2: WORD and Respondus; SoftChalk 1, 2 and 3; Camtasia 1, 2 and 3; ResponseWare, PollEverywhere; NearPod; ShowMe and EduCreations. IDT members are invited to propose additional topics for training. Faculty, both full time and adjunct, can be compensated for the training.
